

How It Works

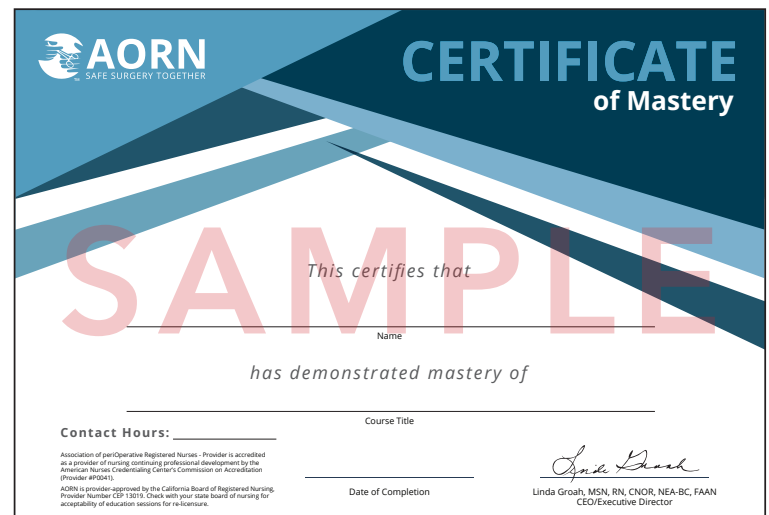
